

CHRISTOPH KELLER on KIOSK – Modes of Multiplication

Christoph Keller, the founder and former director of Revolver – Archiv für aktuelle Kunst in Frankfurt and the curator of KIOSK, is visiting New Zealand. Keller will talk on independent publishing, its mechanics, structures, economy and about his work with the publishing house Revolver and KIOSK.

KIOSK – Modes of Multiplication is a travelling archive of independent publishing projects on contemporary art compiled since 2001. Currently comprising more that 4000 publications KIOSK is now landing in New Zealand, its first stop outside Europe. The exhibition will be on at The Physics Room from 10 May – 3 June.
